SAINTFIELD IS A QUALIFYING SHOW FOR THE TESCO RARE BREEDS SHEEP DERBY

The highest placed eligible adult male animal and the highest placed eligible adult female animal, a total of two qualifiers from each show, will go forward to the final at Gosford on the 3rd September 2011, provided that the animal has not already qualified at a previous show, in which case the next highest placed animal will be selected. Qualifiers will only be chosen from 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings. Junior classes, with the exception of those selected as Champion or Reserve Champion will not be eligible. Sheep which do not carry a DARD approved ear tag will not be eligible.

Qualifying shows being –

Balmoral, Ballymena, Armagh, Saintfield, Omagh, Castlewellan, Antrim, Clogher Valley and Fermanagh.

All animals must be owned and exhibited by a fully paid up member of the Rare Breeds Survival Trust or a child of a fully paid up member of the Trust.
